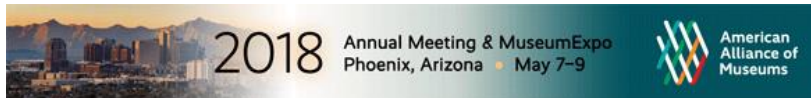




Experience the WideTEK® 36ART on its Worldwide Tour

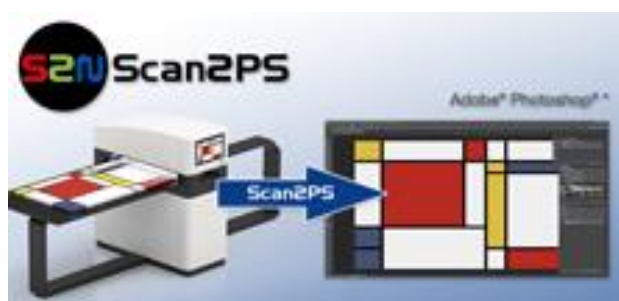
